



TO MAKE MARBLED PAPER

Materials

- **Water**
- **Large art paper**
- **Many different coloured inks**
- **Large shallow tray**
- **Drying rack**
- **A small container**
- **Stirrer e.g. a straw or a paddle pop stick**

Method

- 1. Place the tray in the centre of the centre of the table.**
- 2. Fill the container with water.**
- 3. Pour the water into the tray.**
- 4. Repeat this until the bottom of tray is covered with water.**
- 5. Choose a bottle of ink.**
- 6. Remove its top and slowly squeeze a few drops into the water.**
- 7. Repeat this process using a few colours.**
- 8. Take the stirrer and spread the colour over the water's surface.**
- 9. Use two hands to hold the paper horizontally.**
- 10. Lower the paper gently onto the water surface.**
- 11. Lift the paper slowly and allow the extra water to drip off.**
- 12. Lay the paper on the rack to dry.**

CAUTION: Do not over mix the inks or the mixture will turn brown.
