

TO MAKE MARBLED PAPER

Materials

- Many different coloured inks
- Large art paper
- Water
- Large shallow tray
- Drying rack
- A stirrer e.g. a straw or paddle pop stick
- A small container

Method

1. Place the tray in the centre of the table.
2. Fill the container with water.
3. Pour the water into the tray.
4. Repeat this until the bottom of the tray is covered with water.
5. Choose a bottle of ink.
6. Remove its top and slowly squeeze a few drops into the water.
7. Repeat this process using a few colours.
8. Take stirrer and spread the colour over the waters surface.
9. Use two hands to hold to art paper horizontally.
10. Lower the paper gently onto the water surface.
11. Lift the paper slowly and allow the extra water to drip off.
12. Lay the paper on the rack to dry.

CAUTION Do not over mix the inks or the mixture will turn brown.
